## 1. Budget for 2023/24

This is prepared on the basis of the following assumptions.

- 1. Two face-to-face popular lectures (including Christmas lecture).
- 2. Three online/hybrid popular lectures.
- 3. One online lecture directed at primary schools.
- 4. Open Challenge as in 22/23.
- 5. PMQ as in 22/23 with support from LJMU.
- 6. There are many 5 year memberships expiring in 2023, including some with whom we have had no contact for some time; I am therefore assuming that half of these will be renewed at the same rate together with the 1 year memberships (or equivalent new memberships).
- 7. Roadshow sales similar to 22/23.
- 8. Bookshop similar to 22/23.
- 9. Bank charges of £60 for LivMS and £60 for the Bursary Fund.
- 10. Donation to Bursary Fund of £1500.
